What is COIL?



Integration

COIL projects are integrated into **existing courses** at both partner institutions (you don't need to create something entirely new).



Collaboration

Students work with international peers to solve a problem or complete a project over five to ten weeks.



Skill Building

Students develop skills in intercultural communication, problem-solving, teamwork, and global perspectives.

WORKSHOP GOALS AND EXPECTED OUTCOMES



Partnership

Faculty members will interact with international partners and identify a joint project.



Content

Learn about the elements of COIL, its challenges and opportunities.



Implementation

Adapt a syllabus to integrate a COIL project in collaboration with an international partner. COIL classes will be taught in spring of 2027 or fall 2028.



Recognition

Professors who complete the program will receive a certificate of recognition and a letter they can use for their tenure and promotion portfolio.
